T5007 Tax Slips Information for Clients

What is a T5007 Tax Slip?

The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) requires that everyone who receives provincial income assistance or disability assistance reports this income on his or her tax return. Clients who receive more than \$500 in assistance receive a T5007 tax slip to help them prepare their tax returns. The income shown on the T5007 is not taxable but is used to calculate entitlement to federal tax credits like the GST credit and Child Tax Benefit.

When are T5007s mailed?

T5007s will be mailed to clients by the fourth week in February.

What if I didn't receive a T5007?

The Ministry of Housing and Social Development provides duplicates of T5007s. Clients can obtain the information they need to complete their tax return by:

1. Calling the T5007 information line **1 877 815-2363** to obtain their T5007 total over the phone (they do not need to attach an actual T5007 to their tax return); or
2. Going to their Employment and Income Assistance Office and requesting a print-out of their TAX-Q screen.

How are T5007s calculated?

Assistance months included in T5007s

All reportable assistance issued in the calendar year is included on the tax slip. Usually, this will be for the assistance months from January to December.

Assistance included in T5007s

Most of the assistance included on the T5007 is for basic support and shelter.

Assistance not included in T5007s

Medical and health supplements, child care subsidy assistance, and crisis supplements are not included on the T5007.

Requesting detailed T5007 calculation

If you wish to review your T5007 calculation, your Employment and Income Assistance Office can provide a print-out of the TAX-Q screen upon request.
