Two applicants/recipients with or without dependent children	One applicant/recipient is a person with disabilities, the other is not a person with disabilities and is under 65 years of age	\$700.56
Two applicants/recipients with or without dependent children	Both applicants/recipients are persons with disabilities	\$949.06
Two applicants/recipients with or without dependent children	One applicant/recipient is a person with disabilities, the other is not a person with disabilities but is 65 or more years of age	\$949.06

- In addition to the support allowance, families receive \$123.50 for each child to age 19 years, under the BC Family Bonus and ministry top-up if the Family Bonus is less than \$123.50 or the child is ineligible for Family Bonus.
